- Rio Framework Convention on Climate Change, UNFCCC (1992), ILM 849 (1992), BGBl. II 1993, 1783, 198 Treaty Parties (197 States and 1 regional economic integration organization), in force since 21 March 1994, binding on Germany since 9 December 1993.
- Kyoto Protocol (1997), 37 ILM 22 (1998), BGBl. 2002 II 966, 192 Treaty Parties excluding the US, in force since 16 February 2005, binding on Germany since 31 May 2002 (phased out).
- Paris Climate Agreement of 14 December 2015, 194 Treaty Parties (193 states plus the European Union) (197 signatories), signed by Germany on 22 April 2016. Threshold for entry into force at 55:55 ("double trigger", Art. 21) reached on 5 October 2016, entry into force (also for Germany) on 4 November 2016.

 Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS) (1994), 1867 UNTS 493, WTO Doc LT/UR/A-1A/12, BGBl. 1994 I 1438, 164 Treaty Parties (= WTO members), entry into force on 1 January 1995, binding on Germany since 1 January 1995.
